After Aug.28, 2022 voters must show a non-expired Missouri DMV or Federal ID to vote.

Want to vote in November but don't have a non-expired Missouri ID?

- Out of State ID? Expired Missouri ID?
- No Missouri Driver or Non-Driver License?
- Lack transportation to DMV Office?
- Can't get off work when DMV office is open?
- Don't have certified birth certificate or Naturalization papers?
- Errors in name or dates on birth certificate?
- Don't have a photo ID to request birth certificate from another state?
- Name changed but don't have court documents of name change?
- Don't have marriage license?
- Don't have regular internet access?

Impacted Communities:

- Seniors with expired ID
- People who don't drive
- People with disabilities
- Those without a birth certificate
- Those born at home
- Those with errors on underlying docs
- Students with out of state IDs
- Unhoused, those in Shelters
- Returning citizens
