Parish Mission Statement

St. Francis' Episcopal Church is a growing and inviting community of Christians known for meaningful worship and faithful service to God, our neighbors, and each other.

Duties

- Select service music in consultation with the Vicar
- Play for two Sunday services weekly and special services such as Christmas and Holy Week
- Develop a strategy for congregational singing in consultation with Vicar
- Collaborate with parishioner led handbell choir as needed
- Schedule tuning/maintenance of pianos and organ
- Participate in staff and worship meetings as needed, not to exceed two meetings monthly
- First Right of Refusal for all weddings, funerals, and other liturgical events at St. Francis which include additional compensation
- Coordinate substitutes for vacation or leave
- Collaborate with the Vicar and Wired Worship ministry for online worship services and music recordings as required by diocesan pandemic protocols

Necessary Skills

- Comfort and dexterity in accompanying a variety of musical styles from traditional Anglican hymnody and chant, to more contemporary pieces such as Lift Every Voice and Sing and Music that Makes Community
- Ability to accurately play piano, organ, or guitar from printed scores
- Choral rehearsal and accompanying experience, including the ability to play vocal parts in open score format
- Ability to build community through music
- Creative
- Ability to communicate digitally and utilize church's communication systems

Time and Payment

- Part time Interim position for six-12 months to be mutually agreed upon by the candidate and Vicar. The possibility for permanent hire exists.
- Compensation based on experience
- Vacation, substitutes, and other considerations are negotiable
