# Province V Executive Board report to the Diocese of Missouri 2021-2022

**Province V** is a network of 14 dioceses of the Episcopal Church as defined by the Canons of the General Convention (2018). The primary purposes of the Provinces are to facilitate inter-diocesan collaboration to achieve Diocesan and Episcopal Church goals, and to enable more effective communications and regional advocacy of significant programmatic efforts – or, more simply put – Connect, Network, and Support. Each diocese contributes an apportionment to the Province to support ministries and networking opportunities. # Big Provincial Gathering and Synod meeting – April 2022

As many of you experienced, we had a great gathering in South Bend in April! Almost 200 people were able to experience the vibrancy of our Province at the Big Provincial Gathering and Synod. While our keynote speaker, House of Deputies President The Rev. Gay Clark Jennings, was unable to attend in person due to COVID-19, she sent her speech to Canon Jane Cisluycis who presented it to the gathering. The main business sessions and worship were live streamed and recorded. The Synod included the business of passing several resolutions and the provincial budget, and "commercials" from each of the various networks and affiliated organizations. There were several pre-event trainings that were offered. Friday and Saturday included group worship opportunities, a variety of workshops that were offered by the networks, and the election of Province V's lay representative to the Executive Council of the General Convention and the officers of the Province V Executive Board. Sponsors ensured that we were able to offer the program at a discounted price for everyone.
